<sup>§</sup>MSc students are guaranteed funding for a minimum of two years and PhD students are guaranteed for a minimum of five years (including the 1.5 years as a MSc student prior to transferring to the PhD program), provided they remain “in good standing”.

<sup>†</sup>A 0.25 TAsip is 96 hours in total and a 0.5 TAsip is 192 hours in total. A 0.5 TAsip can be spread over two terms (i.e. 96 hours per term).

<sup>‡</sup>Fees include student fees as well as the cost of the “U-Pass” transit pass and the AMS/GSS Extended Health Plan. Most of these fees are mandatory, but some have opt-out provisions.

\*For the first four years of a PhD, students will receive a BMB Graduate Tuition Award provided that:  
i) The student shows satisfactory progress as documented by an annual committee meeting report.

- ii) Departmental funds are available. In the rare event that there is a shortfall of departmental funds, a fraction of the BMB Graduate Tuition Award will be awarded. ***Note that this has never happened.***
- iii) The student has NOT received an Alexander Graham Bell Canada Graduate Scholarships (CGSD), a NSERC Postgraduate Scholarships (PGSD), or a CIHR Doctoral Research Award and thus have their tuition covered by an associated Four-Year Fellowship awarded by UBC.
- iv) The student has not received a Vanier Canada Graduate Scholarship.
