- Number of positions:** three one-quarter time Teaching Assistant positions are available
- Qualifications:** Applicants must have completed a bachelor or master degree in a relevant discipline and be a full-time graduate student at the University of British Columbia. Applicants should have good communication skills and enjoy facilitating student discussions.
- Duties:**
- 1) Reading case studies to prepare for problem-based learning tutorials
 - 2) Facilitating discussion and assessing students during problem-based learning tutorials
 - 3) Answering questions via e-mail and the discussion board
 - 4) Evaluating student assignments
- Hours of work:** Problem-based learning tutorials are Tues/Thurs 12pm-1pm. Teaching Assistants will be expected to prepare for tutorials, answer questions and evaluate student assignments outside of class time. The hours for preparation, grading and answering questions are flexible. The maximum time worked will be 92 hrs (excluding vacation) for this quarter-time appointment.
