<sup>1</sup>MSc students are guaranteed funding for a minimum of two years and PhD students are guaranteed for a minimum of five years (including the 1.5 years as a MSc student prior to transferring to the PhD program), provided they remain “in good standing”.

<sup>2</sup>A 0.25 TAship is 96 hours in total and a 0.5 TAship is 192 hours in total. A 0.5 TAship can be spread over two terms (i.e. 96 hours per term).

<sup>3</sup>Students awarded major (i.e. greater than \$15,000 per year), merit-based (for example: NSERC/CIHR CGS M, NSERC PGS D, or UBC Four-Year Fellowships) awards will receive a minimum of \$28,000 per year financial support before tuition and excluding TAships.

<sup>4</sup>Fees include student fees, the cost of the “U-Pass” transit pass, the AMS/GSS Extended Health Plan, and the Health-Care Coverage Fee for international students. Most of these fees are mandatory, but some have opt-out provisions.

<sup>5</sup>For the first four years of a PhD, students will receive a BMB Graduate Tuition Award provided that:

- i) The student shows satisfactory progress as documented by an annual committee meeting report.
- ii) Departmental funds are available. In the rare event that there is a shortfall of departmental funds, a fraction of the BMB Graduate Tuition Award will be awarded. ***Note that this has never happened.***
- iii) The student has NOT received a UBC Four-Year Fellowship, an NSERC Postgraduate Scholarship (PGS D) or a CIHR Doctoral Research Award and thus have their tuition covered by UBC.
- iv) The student has NOT received an Alexander Graham Bell Canada Graduate Scholarship (CGS D) or a Vanier Canada Graduate Scholarship.

<sup>6</sup>Presidents Academic Excellence Initiative PhD Award is available to all new and continuing PhD students except those who have their tuition paid by an external sponsor.
