

BIOC 551 - Advanced Topics in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology

Course Description:

BIOC 551 is an introductory course that provides all incoming graduate students with an introduction to the scientific process, peer-review publications, scientific writing, lab management/conflicts and scholarly integrity and a comprehensive overview of biochemical, biophysical and molecular approaches. The course consists of a series of modules taught by 15 instructors. Students will be graded based on their presentations, assignments, participation, and a written career development plan.
